


Zinnias

Start with a
boundary-measure
width and height
Add center.
If flower is convex,
folding over, then
center is higher in oval.



- ✤ Add a spiral that gradually gets bigger
- Fill in petals. Petals meet the ones above them in their center. Petals automatically get bigger as they go toward boundary.
- Don't worry about petals in back that you cannot see.
- Begin shading in between petals from dark corner out softly onto petal below.
- Shade left side of flower as you would a ball.
