


Composite Centers

The disc flowers in the center of the aster family are made up of small five petaled flowers laid out in the Fibonacci sequence, a set of spirals.

Hints for showing the complicated center:

- Use lots of different pencils to indicate lots of little flowers.
- Use your pencil to draw many small circles or stars.
- Look for ways to show roundness-darks and lights (rudbeckia.)
- Sometimes it helps to start with yellow and carve out the flower shapes (zinnia.)
- Loose and playful usually works best.
